What is a Page? A Page is the title given to a child that meets the requirements & submits this application What is the Little Miss and Little Mister? This is the title of one girl and one boy randomly drawn by name to fill this title.

Requirements:

If a child was a participant in prior years, they are NOT eligible for the 2024 Pancake Day Pageant. They must also be enrolled for kindergarten & reside or attend school in Appanoose County for the 2024-2025 school year. Entry fee (\$25.00) must be paid when application is turned in. The first 10 girls, and the first 10 boys applications with entry fees will be this year's pages. No spots will be held, as this is on a first come basis!

Photography Headshots: The deadline to schedule your child's picture to be taken by Myra's Studio is <u>Friday, June 14</u>th. Please call Myra at Myra's Portrait Studio at 641-856-8116. They must wear their Pancake Day T-shirt and denim bottoms. We ask that the child's skin be clean with no make-up applied to your child's face.

Pancake Day T-Shirts are included in your entry fee. There are no additional costs. Headshots are donated by Myra's Studio.

Selection: The 2024 Little Miss and Little Mister will be selected by random, live on GoPitchTV. Date will be

announced via the Band App

Expectations: All kids are required to participate in the Pancake Day Pageant on Saturday, September 28th.

They will all be involved in a performance on Pancake Day during the queen pageant. The Little Miss and Mister will, and take pictures with the court at the Presbyterian Church on Hwy 2 and

South Main immediately following the pageant (all other pages may leave with their

parents/guardians at that time). We do understand that things don't always go as planned with children. If your child is struggling with being on stage or cooperating, we ask that parents stay available to help your child as the committee is not able to leave their stations or group during

the program.

Attire: Pancake Day t-shirt with a denim bottom of choice during the parade and for the pageant.
